Any work previously exhibited at AMOA is ineligible.

PRESENTATION

Works must be professionally presented and ready for installation upon delivery.

Works on paper must be matted and/or framed.

Sculptures can be no more than 50 pounds in weight.

Paintings & photography must be framed and/or have finished edges.
