

WATERCOLOR PUMPKIN



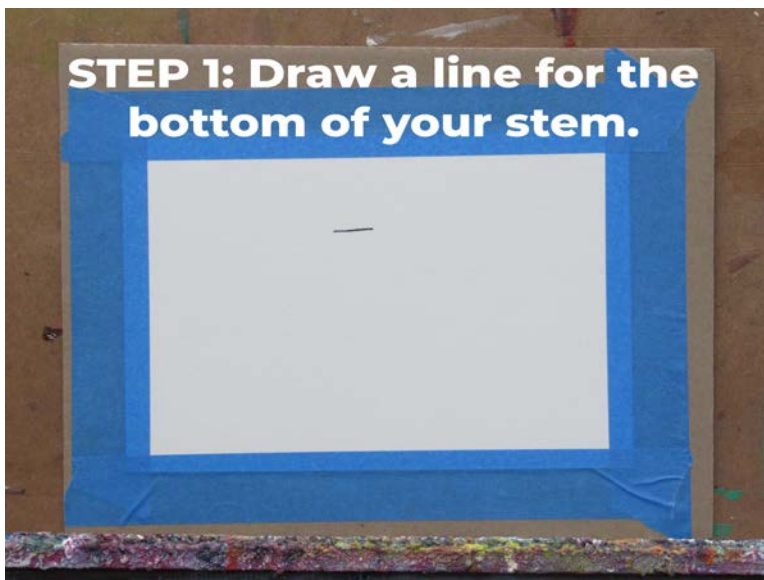
KIT INCLUDES

- Watercolor Set & Brush
- Black Glue
- Pencil
- Water Cup

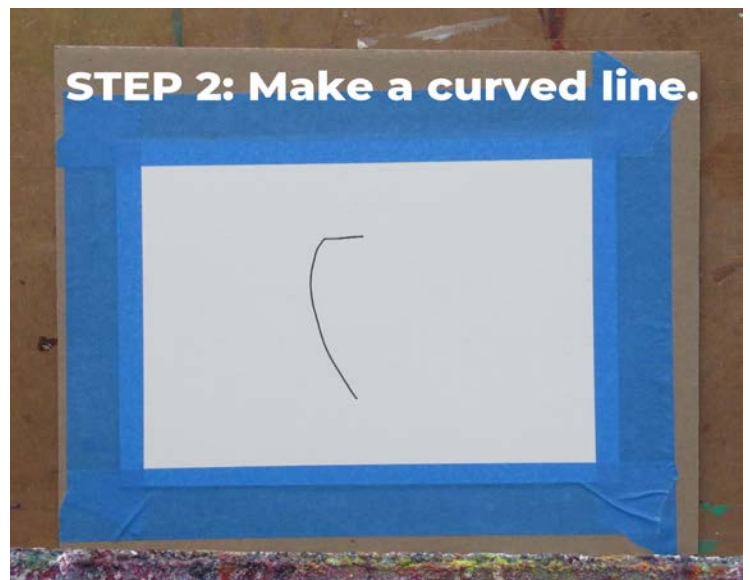
Step 1:

Draw your pumpkin. You can follow these steps or make your own!

STEP 1: Draw a line for the bottom of your stem.



STEP 2: Make a curved line.



STEP 3: Make another curved line that meets the other line at the bottom point.



STEP 4: Draw another curved line that begins at the top



STEP 4: Draw another curved line that begins at the top and ends at the bottom point.



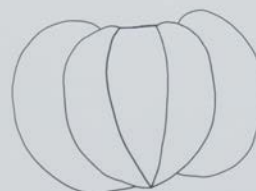
STEP 5: Repeat on the other side.



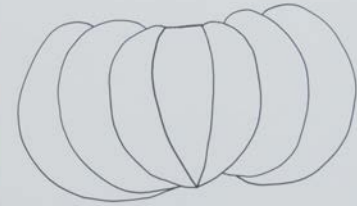
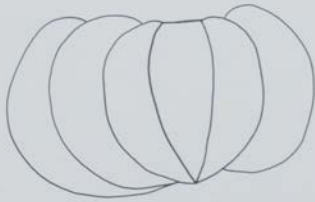
STEP 6: Draw another curved line. This line does not have to start and end at the same points like your previous lines.



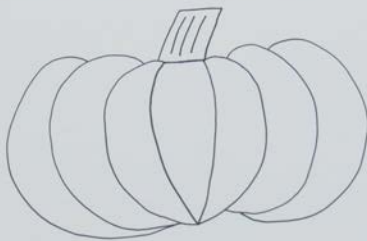
STEP 7: Repeat on the other side.



STEP 8: Continue drawing curved lines outward to make your pumpkin.



STEP 9: Draw a stem.



STEP 10: Add some squiggly vines.

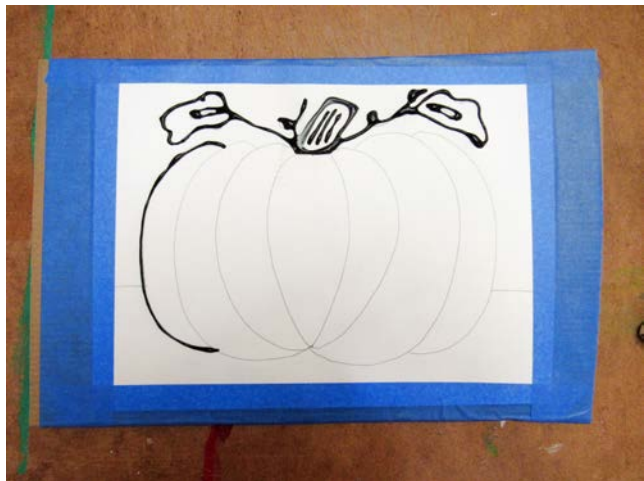


STEP 12: Add leaves and a line behind the pumpkin that is half way down the page or lower.



Step 2:

Trace the pencil drawing of your pumpkin with the black glue. You may need to shake the glue some before use. (Black tempera paint has been added to the glue.) As you are squeezing, make sure to keep the tip slightly above and off the paper. Let the glue dry before you move onto the next step!



Step 3:

Once the glue is dry, grab your watercolors and begin painting! Once the paint is dry slowly remove the blue tape around the edge. What other objects can you draw, outline, and paint?
